With this Application, please send a copy of your child's foreign birth certificate, adoption decree, abandonment certificate, I-171H, permanent resident card ("Green Card"), foreign passport showing the photo page and the visa page w/alien registration number, and your check payable to "**Patti Urban - Legal-Eaze**" in the amount of \$500.

Once I have received this application, I will complete the legal documents necessary for you to use to file for the readoption of your child.

The readoption process time varies by county. It can take anywhere from 1 to 3 months to complete. A readoption will also allow you to change your child's name and obtain a California birth certificate for your child.

Legal-Eaze is a company I started in 1996 after working for 20 years as a paralegal. Our primary goal is to provide parents who are adopting from overseas easy access to the international adoption system by helping them help themselves. The services provided **pre-adoption** include: completing and filing immigration documents, consultation with your social worker to coordinate dossier documents, dossier preparation, vital records, dossier authentication, visas, and expedited courier service to New York City Consulates and Government Offices. The services provided **post-adoption** include: readoptions, wills, and consultation and assistance with Certificates of Citizenship, U.S. Passports, Social Security Numbers, and Return of Original Documents from USCIS (formerly INS). All post-adoption paperwork is completed under the direct supervision of the parent.

In April of 1997, my husband and I independently adopted our first daughter, Kristen Mingxia, from Yangzhou, China. In October of 1999, we returned from China with our second daughter from Yangzhou, Juliana Xiaoye. In January of 2002, I traveled alone to China to adopt our third child, Mary Kate Xiru, also from Yangzhou. And finally, in September of 2006, we brought home our son, Kevin from Shangrao, through China's Waiting Child program. As an adoptive parent myself, I can easily relate to other families in their adoption journey in addition to offering many years of experience. The costs for these high-quality services are kept low because my staff and I are not lawyers--we do not give legal advice nor do we represent you. We do, however, assist adoptive parents with the many forms they need to complete.
